

Our Data Protection Statement

We place great importance on customer service and in order to achieve this we need to hold accurate personal data about you.

The personal data we use may include:-

- Full name and personal details including contact information (e.g. home address, home address history, e-mail address, home and mobile telephone numbers).

We ask you to positively opt in with consent for us to use your personal data and that you can withdraw your consent at any time.

We have a legal obligation under the Data Protection Act 1998 and the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) May 2018 to ensure that all personal data held complies with the principles of the above Act and Regulations.

Any personal data provided is collected on behalf of Hunstanton Holidays and will be used only in the administration of your holiday enquiry and or booking.

Any personal data provided will be processed in a manner that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures.

Your personal data may be used for future marketing purposes only by Hunstanton Holidays, but it will never be disclosed to any third party except to help prevent fraud, if asked to do so by law or a regulator.

Hunstanton Holidays may transfer its business assets (which includes personal data) on the sale or merger of any part of its business.

The use of your personal data is covered by our notification under the Data Protection Act 1998.

Your rights under the applicable data protection law:-

- The right **to be informed** about our processing of your personal data.
- The right **to rectification** i.e. have your personal data corrected if it's inaccurate or incomplete.
- The right **to object** to processing of your personal data.
- The right **to restrict processing** of your personal data.
- The right **to erasure** also known as (the 'right to be forgotten'). You can make a request for erasure verbally or in writing.

- The right **to access** an electronic copy of the personal data we hold about you, free of charge.
- The right **to data portability** i.e. to move, copy or transfer your personal data.
